Begun and held in Metro Manila, on Monday, the twenty-eight day of July, two thousand fourteen.

[REPUBLIC ACT No. 10677]

AN ACT INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE NORTHERN MINDANAO MEDICAL CENTER IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7938, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representative of the Philippines in Congress assembled: SECTION 1. Section 2 of Republic Act No. 7938 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. The hospital facilities of the Northern Mindanao Medical Center shall be upgraded and increased, consistent with the requirements of modern medical technology and its status as a medical center. Accordingly, its bed capacity shall be increased from three hundred (300) beds to six hundred (600) beds.

SEC. 2. Section 3 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows

"SEC. 3. The number of medical personnel, the budget for personnel services and mainte nance and other operating expenses of the Northern Mindanao Medical Center shall correspondingly be increased. The Department of Health, in coordination with the Department of Budget and Manage ment, shall determine the additional plantilla positions to be created pursuant to this Act."

SEC. 3. There is hereby added a new Section 4 to read as follows:

"SEC. 4. The increase in bed capacity of the Northern Mindanao Medical Center from three hundred (300) to six hundred (600) beds shall be implemented immediately upon approval of this Act."

SEC. 4. Section 4 of the same Act is hereby renumbered as Section 5 and amended to read as

"SEC. 5. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.

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BIR urged to preserve sin tax law gains via **MCP**

he author in the House of the bill mandating a minimum price on cigarettes urged the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) to consider imposing an ad interim minimum cigarette price (MCP) to keep the gains of the sin tax law and its avowed goal to curb smoking.

Romblon Rep. Eleandro Madrona said the BIR has powers under the National Internal Revenue Code of 1997 and Republic Act 10351 or the Sin Tax law to ensure successful and proper implementation of the law, which raised excise taxes on cigarettes to curb smoking among Filipinos.

'While Congress hits fever pitch because of the upcoming elections, it behooves for the BIR to fill in the momentary legislative paralysis and ensure that no cheap cigarettes would be accessible to the youth," Madrona said.

He said with the election fever grip-

ping Congress, the most likely accomplishment of both chambers is passing the 2016 national budget.

Madrona said the gains of Sin Tax law are being threatened by the continued proliferation of very cheap cigarettes - contraband or counterfeit - that are being sold in the market and are being bought by the youth.

If cheap cigarettes remain accessible to the youth, then something must be introduced or strengthened to ensure the successful implementation of the Sin Tax law that we voted upon as the ultimate anti-smoking law," Madrona, who also chairs the House accounts committee, said.

The House leader said BIR could consider issuing a revenue regulation or a memorandum circular to mandate an MCP on all cigarette products and direct its personnel to check price-related activities that often result to cheaper cigarettes.

He also said a BIR-imposed MCP would make it easier to flag cigarette companies and retailers that are selling cigarettes way below their combined tax and manufacturing costs - which are indications of tax evasion, smuggling, or even counterfeiting.

Madrona said he expects the MCP to boost Sin Tax collections, which have reached ₱11.9 billion in August this year, ₱8.6 billion of which represents tobacco excise taxes

Under RA 10351, cigarette packs that cost below ₱11.50 are to be taxed ₱21 this year, up from ₱17 last year, while those that are priced \$11.50 and above are slapped ₱28, slightly up from ₱27

Madrona said Congress would come in later with an enacted MCP law to provide structure and permanence to BIR's MCP order.

"We're asking BIR to take a proactive stance on this urgency before the situation gets worse and considering that a national elections is coming up and that a new government would be installed thereafter," he said.

"We just can't go to an electoral sabbatical while cigarette companies lure our youth with their very cheap and dangerous products," Madrona added.

He likewise clarified that his MCP bill was not meant to belittle the gains of Sin Tax Law or an attempt to amend it even as he stressed that his bill provides additional muscle to keep cigarettes out of reach of teenagers through the combined strength of "Sin tax Law" and "MCP"

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
