UPON APPROVAL



1 SEC. 2. Upon the date of effectivity as specified in
2 column 4, all articles listed in the preceding Section in
3 so far as amended by this Act which are entered, or
4 withdrawn from warehouses, in the Philippines, for
5 consumption, shall be subject to the rates of import duties
6 prescribed in column 3, in accordance with Section 104 of
7 the Tariff and Customs Code: Provided, that the term "UPON
8 LIBERALIZATION" under column 4 in the preceding section shall
9 be in accordance with the schedules as provided under Central
10 Bank Circular Nos. 1127 and 1128 and such other Circulars
11 issued in relation thereto.

12 SEC. 3. The nomenclature and present rates of import duty
13 provided for under Presidential Decree No. 1464, otherwise known as
14 the Tariff and Customs Code of 1978, as amended, on articles not
15 physically reproduced herein and marked "x x x x" shall remain in
16 full force and effect.

17 SEC. 4. The ad valorem rates of import duties indicated
18 hereof shall be subject to modification by Congress after review
19 and recommendation by the National Economic and Development Authority
20 after one (1) year from the effectivity of the rates herein
21 prescribed: Provided, that before any recommendation is
22 submitted to Congress pursuant to this Section, the Tariff
23 Commission shall conduct an investigation in the course of
24 which it shall hold public hearings wherein interested
25 parties shall be afforded reasonable opportunity to be present,
26 produce evidence and to be heard. The Tariff Commission shall also
27 hear the views and recommendations of any government office, agency
28 or instrumentality concerned.

1 Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, the
2 National Economic and Development Authority shall
3 recommend to Congress the necessary adjustment in such specific
4 rates of import duties indicated hereof after six (6) months from
5 their effectivity; Provided finally, that the President

6 may not increase or decrease any ad valorem or specific
7 rate herein provided when Congress is in session.

8 SEC. 5. When an article falling within a heading or
9 subheading is subject to an ad valorem or specific rate of
10 duty, it shall be subject to either the ad valorem or specific
11 rate of duty, whichever is higher.

12 SEC. 6. The Commissioner of Customs, subject to the
13 approval of the Secretary of Finance shall promulgate rules
14 and regulations necessary for the implementation of Section
15 5 hereof.

16 SEC. 7. All laws, orders, issuances, rules and regulations
17 or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed
18 or modified accordingly.

19 SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
