MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on Local Government to which was referred Senate Bill No. 162, introduced by Senator Pimentel, Jr., entitled:

"AN ACT CREATING THE REGIONAL CONSULTATIVE COMMISSION, DESCRIBING ITS POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendations that the bill be approved, with the following amendments:

- a) On page 1, line 10 between the words "of" and "members", delete the word "forty (40)" and in lieu thereof place the words "TWENTY-SEVEN (27)"; and
- b) On the same page, line 15, between figure "9" and the word "and", delete the comma (,) after the figure "9" up to the figure "11".

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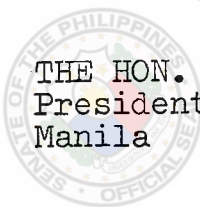

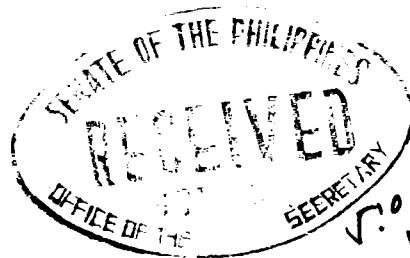

AN ACT
CREATING THE REGIONAL CONSULTATIVE COMMISSION
DESCRIBING ITS POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES
PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

1 SECTION 1. Title of the Act - This Act shall be known as the
2 Regional Consultative Commission Act of 1987, otherwise known in
3 this Act as the "Commission"

4 SECTION 2. Purpose of the Commission - It shall be the function
5 of the Regional Consultative Commission to assist and participate
6 in the enactment of the Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in
7 Muslim Mindanao.

8 SECTION 3. Creation of the Commission - To carry out the above
9 purpose, there is hereby created the Regional Consultative Commission
10 composed of forty (40) members to be appointed by the President of
11 the Philippines from the different multisectoral bodies, namely:
12 women, professionals, peasants, workers, urban poor, youth, local
13 government, cooperatives, and cultural communities coming from Regions 9,
14 10, 11 and 12, provided that, at least, one of such representatives
15 shall come from each of the above-cited multisectoral bodies from each
16 of the regions and provided further, that eight of such representatives
17 shall come from the other multisectoral bodies not otherwise represented
18 herein.

19 SECTION 4. Funding - The amount of TWENTY MILLION (P20,000,000.00)
20 PESOS, Philippine Currency from the National Treasury is hereby

21 appropriated to carry out the purpose for which this commission
22 is formed.

23 SECTION 5. Effectivity - This Act shall take effect
24 immediately upon its approval.
