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AN ACT TO ESTABLISH NEW RATES OF BASE PAY OF MILITARY PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES IN THE ACTIVE SERVICE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Title.*—This Act shall be known as the “AFP  
2 Base Pay Law of 1987.”

3 SEC. 2. *Coverage.*—This Act shall apply to all military  
4 personnel of the Armed Forces of the Philippines in the  
5 active service. Whenever grades are mentioned in this  
6 Act, the same shall mean also the equivalent Navy grades.

1     SEC. 3. *Pay Scale*.—The monthly base pay of the  
 2     military personnel of the Armed Forces of the Philippines  
 3     in the active service shall be as follows:

4 SEC. 4. *Funding Sources*.—This base pay adjustment  
5 amounting to ₱209.5 million shall be funded from the  
6 Compensation and Organizational Adjustment Fund, the  
7 Contingent Fund, and other savings under Executive Order  
8 No. 87, otherwise known as the General Appropriations  
9 Act for Fiscal Year 1987, or from any unappropriated  
10 funds of the National Treasury; *Provided*, That the  
11 corresponding amount for the new salary rates will be  
12 included in the annual General Appropriations Act for  
13 the AFP Budget for the succeeding years.

14 SEC. 5. *Effectivity*.—Any law, executive order, or pres-  
15 idential decree to the contrary notwithstanding, this Act  
16 shall take effect on December 1, 1987.
