## INTRODUCED BY SENATOR SAGUISAG

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE FRANKING PRIVILEGE OF THE MEMBERS OF CONGRESS BEYOND AUGUST 30, 1987

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The franking privilege of the Members of
- 2 Congress which expires on August 30, 1987 is hereby
- 3 extended up to the end of their terms. This privilege will
- 4 also be enjoyed by their successors during their terms.
- 5 SEC. 2. Upon the death of a Member of Congress during
- 6 his or her term of office, his or her spouse may send, for
- 7 a period not to exceed three months after his or her death,
- 8 as franked mail, nonpolitical correspondence relating to
- 9 the death of the Member.

- 1 SEC. 3. The privilege mentioned in Section 1 of this
- 2 Act is available only to assist and expedite the conduct of
- 3 the official businesses, activities, duties of the Congress,
- 4 and will not include matters which are purely personal or
- 5 purely politically partisan, such as seeking political support
- 6 in an election contest.
- 7 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Transportation and Communi-
- 8 cations shall issue the necessary rules and regulations to
- 9 implement this Act.
- 10 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect immediately upon
- 11 approval.
