## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Special benefits and privileges should be given to our elder citizens to enhance their well-being throughout their remaining years. It cannot be denied that during the productive years of their lives our Filipino elders have contributed in the common effort to make this country a better place to live in, no matter how simple and quite.

Having been the direct recipients of our elder's productive years, it is but fitting that we take steps to extend them a more meaningful existence. We must afford them concessions most needed in their years of difficulty caused by sickness, limited mobility, low finances and such other handicaps.

With the present difficulties that the nation is encountering, most, if not all, of us have overlooked or given scant importance to these roots of our lives. But as the saying states " Ang taong hindi marunong lumingon sa pinanggalingan ay hindi makakarating sa paroroonan " it is but imperative upon us who are in a better position to render such recognition to do so in our own way.

This bill will extend to the elderly accommodation without further appropriations necessary to dignify their existence and strengthen their part in the society as they truly deserve.

Considering the foregoing, early approval is earnestly requested.

## AN ACT

GRANTING DISCOUNT PRIVILEGES TO FILIPINO ELDERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. For purposes of this Act, an elder
 is a Filipino citizen, sixty-five (65) years of age
 or over and a resident of the Philippines at the time
 he avails himself of the privilege.

5 SECTION 2. Elderly are further classified as 6 follows:

7 a. One whose gross annual income is more than
8 Twenty-Four Thousand (P24,000.00) Pesos;

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b. Indigent or whose gross annual income is less than Twenty-Four Tbousand (P24,000.00) Pesos

and those who are physically handicapped whose mobility is limited.

SECTION 3. Discount Privileges shall be granted to elderly by the following public utilities, commercial and medical establishments, the Bureau of Internal Revenue and other similar servicing agencies or facilities: []

SECTION 4. Any person or persons, natural or juridical, operating any of the establishments mentioned herein-above who refuses to grant the privilege discounts herein enumerated shall be liable to pay a fine of not less than P200.00 but not more than P500.00 and the cancellation of their license or permit to operate.

23 SECTION 5. The Department of Social Services 24 and Development, in coordination with the Departments 25 of Finance and Health and other government agencies 26 when necessary, is designated as the principal government agency to promulgate the pertinent rules and 27 28 regulations for the proper imphementation of this Act. 29 SECTION 6. Should any provision of this Act 30 be declared unconstitutional, the other provisions 31 unaffected thereby shall remain in force and effect. 32 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon 33 its approval. APPROVED,

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
