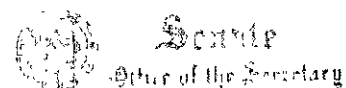

RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE COUNTRY'S OUTSTANDING
POLICEMEN IN SERVICE (COPS) OF 2011 AWARDED BY THE ROTARY
CLUB OF NEW MANILA EAST, METROBANK FOUNDATION, INC. AND
PSBANK

WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation Search for the Country's Outstanding Policemen in Service (COPS) is an annual search jointly undertaken by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc., Rotary Club of New Manila East, and PSBank in consonance with the conviction of these organizations to honor excellence in the pursuit of a vocation;

WHEREAS, as an expression of the civilian sector's appreciation and gratitude for the effort of the Philippine National Police (PNP) in maintaining the peace and order situation in the country and in their respective local communities, the Metrobank Foundation, Inc., the Rotary Club of New Manila East, and the PSBank organized the Search for COPS to recognize the accomplishments of the police force in crime prevention and in crime solution with the help and involvement of the members of the community;

WHEREAS, every year, the competition awards a maximum of ten (10) winners which shall be chosen from among all the Police Commissioned Officers with a rank of police Inspector to Police Superintendent and Police Non-Commissioned Officers with a rank of Police Officer 1 to Senior Police Officer 4 who have met the standard qualifications set by the search and organizing committee;

WHEREAS, the Search for COPS recognizes police officers who are models of excellence and who, through their hardwork and commitment, have helped change the negative public image that the PNP has seemingly acquired, to ultimately inspire the public to work hand in hand with the police in preventing and solving crimes and maintaining public order in the communities;

WHEREAS, this year, COPS awardees include three (3) from the Police Commissioned Officers Category and five (5) from the Police Non-Commissioned Officers Category;
