**RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL DRAGON BOAT TEAM FOR ITS OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE IN THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL DRAGON BOAT FEDERATION WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**WHEREAS**, on August 30 to September 02 at the Idroscalo Club Milan, Italy, the Philippine Canoe Kayak Federation (PCKF) Dragon Boat team bagged six golds and one silver medal during the recently concluded 2012 International Canoe Federation (ICF) Dragon Boat World Championships;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine National Dragon Boat Team took home gold medals in the 10-seater men's 500m, 10-seater mixed 500m, 20-seater mixed 500m, 10 seater men's 200m, 20-seater mixed 200m, and 10-seater mixed 200m and a silver medal in the 20-seater mixed 500m event against such formidable rivals from 13 other countries, including those from traditionally strong contender-countries such as the United States, Russia and Germany;
