

RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO JUNIOR ARCHER GABRIEL LUIS MORENO FOR WINNING THE COUNTRY'S FIRST GOLD MEDAL IN THE 2ND YOUTH OLYMPIC GAMES ON 24 AUGUST 2014 IN NANJING, PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, paid tribute to outstanding Filipino athletes for their astonishing feats, such as becoming champions in international competitions, thereby bringing pride and glory to the country;

WHEREAS, 16-year old Filipino archer Gabriel Luis Moreno made the country proud when he delivered the country's first Olympic gold medal in the 2nd Youth Olympic Games in Nanjing, People's Republic of China on 24 August 2014;

WHEREAS, Gabriel Luis Moreno who teamed up with Chinese archer Li Jianan in the mixed international team archery against archers Muhammad Zoklepele of Malaysia and Cynthia Freywald of Germany thereby clinching the gold medal victory with a score of 38-37, 37-35, 37-33;

WHEREAS, junior archer Gabriel Luis Moreno holds the distinction of being the first Filipino gold medalist in the Youth Olympic Games;

WHEREAS, by winning in this international competition, Gabriel Luis Moreno has made our country proud and has shown the world the country's prospects for excellence and international dominance in the sport of archery;

WHEREAS, this outstanding performance by our Filipino junior archer deserves to be commended for the honor and recognition he has brought our country.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Philippines congratulates and commends Filipino junior golfer archer Gabriel Luis Moreno for winning the country's first gold medal in the 2nd Youth Olympic Games on 24 August 2014 in Nanjing, People's Republic of China.
