RESOLUTION

URGING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SERVICES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE EXISTING PROCEDURES AND/OR PROTOCOLS IN THE LAND TRANSPORTATION FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (LTFRB) AMIDST REPORTS OF ALLEGED RAILROADING AND/OR IRREGULARITIES LEADING TO ISSUANCES BY THE BOARD, WITH THE END GOALS OF FORMULATING MEASURES TO UPHOLD THE RIGHT OF PERTINENT STAKEHOLDERS TO BE HEARD, TO ENSURE THAT RELEVANT RECOMMENDATIONS, OPINIONS AND ANALYSES OF INVOLVED GOVERNMENT AGENCIES BE JUDICIOUSLY CONSIDERED, AND TO ULTIMATELY ENSURE THAT THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE RIDING PUBLIC BE SERVED

1 **WHEREAS**, it is the "prime duty of the Government is to serve and protect 2 the people"¹;

WHEREAS, "the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy"²;

8 **WHEREAS**, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board 9 (LTFRB) had reportedly met with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the 10 National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), and the Department of 11 Energy (DOE) to seek said agencies' assistance and guidance in addressing the issue 12 regarding fare hike for Public Utility Jeepneys (PUJs);

14 **WHEREAS**, NEDA relayed its recommendations/analysis to LTFRB, most 15 notable of which are the following:

17a.NEDA recommended a lower (Php0.50) fare hike than what18LTFRB decided to grant (Php1.00);

b. The Php1.00 increase will "push the country's annual inflation 1 up by 0.076 percentage points in 2018" and "it is estimated to 2 contribute 0.221 percentage points" increase in 2019; 3 4 The Php0.50 increase, on the other hand, will only increase the c. 5 inflation by 0.05 percentage points in 2018 and 0.146 6 percentage points in 2019; 7 8 It was recommended that the LTFRB "set a provision that would d. 9 automatically lift the provisional increase in PUB and PUJ fare, 10 should fuel prices decline to a certain level"; and 11 12 The government's "Pantawid Pasada Program" must be 13 e. implemented to help PUJ operators/drivers; 14 15 WHEREAS, NEDA's recommendations were neither considered nor reflected 16 in the LTFRB's Decision dated 18 October 2018 making the previous provisional 17 Php1.00 fare increase permanent and granting an additional permanent Php1.00 18 19 fare increase, thereby making the minimum fare in PUJs Php10.00; 20 WHEREAS, LTFRB, aside from disregarding NEDA's recommendations, only 21 had "one unscheduled board meeting held on 15 October 2018 attended by two (2) 22 members of the Board to discuss the PUJ fare hike" and that said "board meeting" 23 only lasted for 32 minutes and 40 seconds, all according to the "Dissenting Opinion" 24 of Board Member Aileen Lizada (BM Lizada); 25 26 WHEREAS, several days after LTFRB's Decision granting the fare hike, the 27 28 Department of Transportation (DOTr) urged LTFRB to "review" its decision regarding the fare hike in light of consecutive rollbacks in the prices of petroleum products3; 29 30 WHEREAS, it has also been reported that some of the Board Resolutions 31 issued by the LTFRB were issued without the knowledge, participation and/or 32 33 signature of BM Lizada; 34 35 WHEREAS, in addition, it has also been reported that there is nothing in the 36 above-mentioned Board Resolutions which require that said issuances be posted and/or published for pertinent stakeholders/players to be informed and for the latter 37 to meaningfully participate in the procedures of the LTFRB; 38 39 WHEREAS, several transport groups had accused LTFRB of granting routes 40 and/or CPCs/CPCNs to "favored" operators/players without even the prior knowledge 41 and participation of existing operators/drivers, thereby disregarding the "Prior 42 43 Operator Rule";

WHEREAS, there is a need to expose to public scrutiny the processes and procedures in the LTFRB to ensure that pertinent stakeholders, opinions, studies and analyses be judiciously considered and/or heard first and foremost before LTFRB make issuances affecting lives and livelihood of PUV operators and drivers and the riding public;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 7 Senate of the Philippines, to urge the Senate Committee on Public Services to 8 conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, into the existing procedures and/or protocols 9 in the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) amidst reports 10 of alleged railroading and/or irregularities leading to issuances by the board, with 11 the end goals of formulating measures to uphold the right of pertinent stakeholders 12 to be heard, to ensure that relevant recommendations, opinions and analyses of 13 involved government agencies be judiciously considered, and to ultimately ensure 14 that the best interests of the riding public be served; 15
