**A RESOLUTION
DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN
INQUIRY IN AID OF LEGISLATION INTO THE PREPARATION OF THE
PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT FOR THE 30TH SOUTHEAST ASIAN (SEA) GAMES
ON NOVEMBER 30 TO DECEMBER 11, 2019**

WHEREAS, the Philippines will be hosting the 30th Southeast Asian (SEA) Games on November 30 to December 11, 2019;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of fostering inclusiveness, the country desires to tread against the tradition of host countries delimiting the games to where they will most likely gain medals;

WHEREAS, the SEA Games has been reflective of the host country's capacity in performing government functions and hosting international affairs;

WHEREAS, at least 55 sports will take place in the provinces of Clark in Pampanga, Metro Manila, Subic in Zambales, Batangas, La Union, and Tagaytay;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Southeast Asian Games Organizing Committee (PHISGOC) earmarked P7.5 billion for the preparation and operations of the SEA Games;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure a solid preparation and showcase the government's excellence in executing its functions, there is a need to constantly and harmoniously coordinate with the concerned government agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, to direct the appropriate committee to conduct an inquiry in aid of legislation into the preparation of the Philippine government for the 30th Southeast Asian (SEA) Games on November 30 to December 11, 2019.
