RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE BAGSIK TEAM OF THE

EIGHT GOLD, SIX SILVER, AND ONE BRONZE MEDALS IN THE
INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF MUAYTHAI ASSOCIATIONS
(IFMA) WORLD YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN KUALA LUMPUR,
MALAYSIA, ON AUGUST 29, 2022

WHEREAS, Art. XIV, Section 19 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;"
