RESOLUTION

COMMENDING FILIPINO OLYMPIAN AND BOXER, CARLO PAALAM FOR WINNING GOLD MEDAL IN THE MEN'S 54KG BANTAMWEIGHT CLASS AT THE 2022 ASIAN BOXING CONFEDERATION ELITE MEN AND WOMEN BOXING CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN AMMAN, JORDAN

1 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, give recognition
2 and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their exceptional feats of bringing
3 honor, pride and glory to the country by garnering prestigious awards;
4

5 **WHEREAS**, the ASBC or the Asian Boxing Confederation, a non-profit
6 organization that governs the sports of boxing in all its forms in Asia, was established
7 in accordance with Article 60ff of the Swiss Civil Code, and has its legal seat in
8 Lausanne, Switzerland;

10 **WHEREAS**, ASBC's core objective is to promote, improve and spread boxing
11 in all its forms in the context of its educational, cultural and athletic values in order to
12 promote the discipline to the youth in Asia;

14 **WHEREAS**, the 2022 ASBC Asian Elite Men & Women Boxing Championships
15 is the third year where competitions for both men and women are simultaneously
16 held;

1 **WHEREAS**, Carlo Paalam, a Tokyo Olympic silver medalist, captured the men’s
2 54-Kilogram Bantamweight gold medal in the ASBC Asian Elite Boxing Championships
3 in Amman, Jordan on 12 November 2022;

5 **WHEREAS**, Carlo Paalam joined the Philippine National Team in 2013 when he
6 was 15 years old, and Paalam won the men’s flyweight silver medal on his Olympic
7 debut; and at 23 years old, he is the youngest in the Philippines’ Tokyo 2020 boxing
8 team;

10 **WHEREAS**, Carlo’s big win in the said competition, completed the bronze
11 medals won by Nesthy Petecio in the women’s 57-Kilogram Featherweight, and Hergie
12 Bacayan in the women’s 75-Kilogram Middleweight Class;

14 **WHEREAS**, Carlo has consistently showed determination, resiliency, and
15 world-class talent of Filipinos in sports to every competition he has joined;

17 **WHEREAS**, Carlo’s outstanding performance in the boxing arena deserves
18 recognition for bringing pride and honor to our country, and for inspiring fellow boxers
19 and athletes to be consistent in their perseverance and vigor in their respective fields;

21 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to commend
22 Filipino Olympian and Boxer, Carlo Paalam for winning gold medal in the Men’s 54-
23 Kilogram Bantamweight Class at the 2022 Asian Boxing Confederation Elite Men and
24 Women Boxing Championships held in Amman, Jordan.
