RESOLUTION No. 20

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SENATOR AQUILINO Q. PIMENTEL, JR. TO ARGUE, TOGETHER WITH THE COUNSEL-OF-RECORD, THE PETITION FOR PROHIBITION AND CERTIORARI WITH PRAYER FOR A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION FILED AGAINST THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES, REPRESENTED BY THE SENATE PRESIDENT, THE HONORABLE MANNY VILLAR

WHEREAS, on 6 September 2007, Retired Justices Santiago Javier Rañada and Oswaldo Agcaoili filed a petition for Prohibition and Certiorari with prayer for a Temporary Restraining Order and Permanent Injunction to stop the Senate reinvestigation of "Hello, Garci" wire tapping controversy, docketed as G. R. No. 179275;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court *En Banc*, in a Resolution dated 25 September 2007, resolved to set the case for ORAL ARGUMENT on 2 October 2007, Tuesday at 1:00 P.M. at the New Session Hall, New Supreme Court Building, Manila: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Senate, as it hereby resolves, To authorize Senator Aquilino Q. Pimentel Jr., to argue, together with the counsel-of-record, the Petition for Prohibition and Certiorari with a prayer for a Temporary Restraining Order and Permanent Injunction filed against the Senate of the Philippines, represented by the Senate President, the Honorable Manny Villar.
