Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 22 of Republic Act No. 8552 is hereby amended to
read as follows:

3 "SEC. 22. Rectification of Simulated Births. - A person 4 who has [, prior to the effectivity of this Act.] simulated the 5 birth of a child shall not be punished for such act: Provided, 6 That the simulation of birth was made for the best interest of the child WHO [and that he/she] has been consistently considered 7 and treated AS THE DAUGHTER OR SON OF [by] that person [as 8 his/her own son/daughter]: Provided, further, That the 9 10 application for correction of the birth registration and petition for adoption shall be filed within five (5) years from the 11 12 effectivity of this Act and completed thereafter BY

1 DECEMBER 31, 2018: Provided, finally. That such person 2 complies with the procedure as specified in Article IV of this Act and other requirements as determined by the Department. 3 4 "THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE 5 NATIONAL **STATISTICS OFFICE** AND THE LOCAL 6 GOVERNMENT UNITS FOR THE DISSEMINATION OF THIS 7 INFORMATION." SEC. 2. All simulation of births done beyond the effectivity of this Act 8 9 shall no longer be allowed for rectification. SEC. 3. If any provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the 10 11 same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof. 12 SEC. 4. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders and rules and 13 regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or 14 modified accordingly. SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication 15 16 in the Official Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation. Approved,
