AN ACT DECLARING THE SEVENTEENTH OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL STUDENTS' DAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the National Students' Day Act.

SEC. 2. November 17 of every year is hereby declared as National Students' Day in the entire country to honor the efforts of student leaders of the past and to foster student leadership and academic excellence among the students of the present.

SEC. 3. Pursuant to the observance of the National Students' Day, an annual program of activities shall be prepared and implemented with the National Youth Commission (NYC) as the lead agency.

In support thereof, the Department of Education (DepED) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) shall facilitate and promote the commemoration of this day in all public and private schools. The Philippine Information Agency (PIA), in coordination with the NYC, the DepED and the CHED, shall ensure the effective information dissemination of this Act.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.

AN ACT TO STRENGTHEN THE FISCAL AUTONOMY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS BY REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 21 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10121, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "PHILIPPINE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2010"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Section 21 on the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010", is hereby repealed along with the pertinent provisions of its implementing rules and regulations.
- SEC. 2. All references to the local calamity fund under Republic Act
 No. 10121 shall be deleted.
- 8 SEC. 3. All laws, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in any newspaper of general circulation.
