AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE BICOL SPORTS ACADEMY IN THE CAPITAL TOWN OF PILI IN THE PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR TO BE LOCATED IN THE FREEDOM PARK SPORTS COMPLEX AND ALLOCATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established in the Freedom Park Sports Complex in the capital town of Pili in the Province of Camarines Sur, the Bicol Sports Academy, which shall be constituted as the primary sports development and training center for the Bicol Region.

SEC. 2. The provincial government of Camarines Sur, in coordination with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), shall take the necessary steps to upgrade, improve and modernize existing facilities, equipment and personnel of the Bicol Sports Academy, as and when necessary, in order to attain the objectives and purposes of this Act.

The provincial government of Camarines Sur, in coordination with the PSC, shall create the necessary training programs and competitions, as well as the systems by which the facilities are maintained and managed in order to accomplish the objectives and purposes of this Act.

- SEC. 3. The establishment and operation of this project shall be funded by the provincial government of Camarines Sur, by funds that may be available for allocation by the district representative or by other legislators, and such funds as may be granted by the PSC or by the Office of the President. In addition, grants and endowments may be obtained from local or foreign sources intended for sports development.
- SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
