AN ACT SUBDIVIDING BARANGAY MANGAGOY IN THE CITY OF
BISLIG, PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL SUR INTO EIGHT (8)
SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN
AS BARANGAYS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 AND 8

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Subdivision of Barangay Mangagoy.* — Barangay
2 Mangagoy in the City of Bislig, Province of Surigao del Sur is hereby
3 subdivided into eight (8) separate and independent barangays to be known as
4 Barangays 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

5 SEC. 2. *Composition.* — The existing puroks and sitios in Barangay
6 Mangagoy shall comprise the new barangays, to wit:

7 (a) Barangay 1 shall be composed of Barangay Mangagoy Proper,
8 St. Paul, Union Site and Central;

9 (b) Barangay 2 shall be composed of Bongaitan and Market Site;

10 (c) Barangay 3 shall be composed of Caramcam;

11 (d) Barangay 4 shall be composed of Riverside, Bogac;

12 (e) Barangay 5 shall be composed of John Bosco;

- 1 (f) Barangay 6 shall be composed of Panaghiusa;
2 (g) Barangay 7 shall be composed of Castillo Village; and
3 (h) Barangay 8 shall be composed of Gamaon, Manggawong.

4 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – Pursuant to
5 Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local
6 Government Code of 1991, the new barangays shall exist upon the majority of
7 the votes cast by the qualified voters of Barangay Mangagoy in a plebiscite to
8 be conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
9 the area affected, within one hundred twenty (120) days from the effectivity of
10 this Act.

11 The expense for such plebiscite shall be borne by the City of Bislig.

12 SEC. 4. *Barangay Officials.* – The first set of officials of the said
13 barangay shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor, in consultation with
14 the Representative of the District, and shall hold office until such time that
15 their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

16 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All existing public
17 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
18 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and
19 shall be administered by the new barangays.

20 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangays 1, 2, 3, 4, 5,
21 6, 7 and 8 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares
22 pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
23 known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

24 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
25 its publication in any newspaper of general circulation.
