AN ACT CREATING TWO (2) ADDITIONAL BRANCHES OF THE REGIONAL TRIAL COURT IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO BE STATIONED AT THE CITY OF TACLOBAN, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 14, PARAGRAPH (I) OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980", AS AMENDED, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Two (2) additional Regional Trial Court branches are
2 hereby created in the Eighth Judicial Region with seats at the City of Tacloban,
3 Province of Leyte.

4 The Supreme Court shall assign the branch number of the newly-created
5 branches of the Regional Trial Court in the Eighth Judicial Region.

1 SEC. 2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with
2 the Secretary of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the
3 Court's program the operationalization of the two (2) additional branches of
4 the Regional Trial Court in the Province of Leyte to be stationed at the City of
5 Tacloban, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
6 Appropriations Act.

7 SEC. 3. Section 14(i) of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise known
8 as "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended, and all other
9 laws, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby
10 amended, repealed or modified accordingly.

11 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete
12 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general
13 circulation.
