AN ACT DECLARING THE TENTH DAY OF ZHUL HIJJA, THE TWELFTH MONTH OF THE HIJRAH CALENDAR A NATIONAL HOLIDAY FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF EID'L ADHA, AMENDING FURTHER FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 26, CHAPTER 7 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 292, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987, AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The tenth day of Zhul Hijja, the twelfth month of the Islamic 1 Calendar, is hereby declared as a national holiday for the observance of Eid'l 2 3 Adha. SEC. 2. Section 26, Chapter 7 of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise 4 known as the Revised Administrative Code of 1987, as amended, is hereby 5 6 further amended to read as follows: "SEC. 26. Regular Holidays and Nationwide Special Days. 7 - (1) Unless otherwise modified by law, order or proclamation, 8 the following regular holidays and special days shall be observed 9
