AN ACT SEPARATING THE DONSOLO COMPREHENSIVE HIGH SCHOOL –  
BANUANG GURANG EXTENSION IN BARANGAY BANUANG  
GURANG, MUNICIPALITY OF DONSOLO, PROVINCE OF  
SORSOLO FROM THE DONSOLO COMPREHENSIVE HIGH  
SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL  
HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS BANUANG GURANG  
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*  
2       – The Donsolo Comprehensive High School – Banuang Gurang Extension in  
3       Barangay Banuang Gurang, Municipality of Donsolo, Province of Sorsolo is  
4       hereby separated from the Donsolo Comprehensive High School and converted  
5       into an independent national high school to be known as Banuang Gurang  
6       National High School.

7           SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,  
8       liabilities and records of the Donsolo Comprehensive High School – Banuang  
9       Gurang Extension are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Banuang  
10      Gurang National High School.

1           SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* -- The Secretary of Education shall  
2 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the  
3 Banuang Gurang National High School, the initial funding of which shall be  
4 charged against the current year's appropriations of the Donsol Comprehensive  
5 High School – Banuang Gurang Extension. Thereafter, the amount necessary  
6 for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual  
7 General Appropriations Act.

8           SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules  
9 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

10           SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* -- This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
11 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
