Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

containing an area of five hundred fifty-seven thousand seven hundred eighty-nine square meters (557,789 sq. m.), more or less. The administration and maintenance of the Balete Pass National Shrine shall be under the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office.

- SEC. 2. The Secretary of National Defense shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 3. The amount necessary for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the budget of the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
