AN ACT PROHIBITING ANY NATURAL OR JURIDICAL PERSON OR PERSONS TO ENGAGE IN MINING OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CARIGARA BAY AREA, LOCATED BETWEEN THE NORTHERN PORTION OF LEYTE PROVINCE AND BILIRAN PROVINCE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. — It is the policy of the State to protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

Pursuant thereto, utmost care should be taken to preserve marine resources and ecosystems which are the primary sources of food, income and recreation specially of local communities that rely on them.

SEC. 2. *Prohibition.* – No person, firm, entity or group of persons or entities, whether or not licensed to engage in mining operations, is allowed to undertake any mining activity within the Carigara Bay area covering the municipalities of Babatagon, San Miguel, Barugo, Carigara, Capoocan and

For purposes of this Act, the term "mining activity" shall refer to the extraction of valuable minerals or other geological materials from the earth, from an ore body, vein or (coal) seam.

- SEC. 3. *Penal Provision.* Any person, entity or a group of persons or entities found to have violated or have not complied with any of the provisions of this Act shall suffer the penalty of revocation of the mining permits and payment of a fine of not less than One million pesos (P1,000,000.00): *Provided*, That the owners, officers and employees of firms or entities who violate any provision of this Act shall also be held liable and be subject to imprisonment of not less than one (1) year but not more than three (3) years.
- SEC. 4. Repealing Clause. All others laws, decrees, orders, issuances, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 5. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any provision of this Act or any part hereof is declared invalid or unconstitutional, all other sections or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.
- SEC. 6. *Effectivity*. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of national circulation and two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the provinces of Leyte and Biliran.
