AN ACT DECLARING THE CHINESE NEW YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PHILIPPINES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. - It is hereby declared a policy of
 the government to recognize the great contributions of the Chinese-Filipino in
 Philippine society and their rich cultural traditions.

SEC. 2. Special Nonworking Public Holiday. - The Chinese New Year
is hereby declared a special nonworking public holiday in the whole country
every year.

SEC. 3. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The Department of
Labor and Employment, in consultation with the Federation of
Filipino-Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Inc., shall promulgate
the rules and regulations to implement this Act.

 SEC. 4. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon
 its publication in two (2) newspapers of national circulation. Approved,
