BY REPRESENTATIVES EVARDONE, MATUGAS, PALMONES AND CASIÑO, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 2461

AN ACT DECLARING THE PROVINCE OF EASTERN SAMAR A MINING-FREE ZONE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. *Title*. – The Province of Eastern Samar is hereby declared a mining-free zone and all mining operations in the province are hereby prohibited.

As used in this Act, mining operations shall be understood in the sense used under existing mining laws, and shall apply whether the same is conducted in a small scale or otherwise: *Provided, however*, That this Act shall not operate against legitimate quarrying and/or sand and gravel activities in the Province of Eastern Samar.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct mining operations in the Province of Eastern Samar. Any person found guilty violating the provisions of this Act shall be penalized with imprisonment of at least six (6) years but not more than twelve (12) years and a fine of at least

3	If the offender is a corporation, firm, partnership or association, the
4	penalty shall be imposed upon the officer or officers of the corporation, firm,
5	partnership or association responsible for the violation hereof.
6	If the offender is an alien, after service of sentence and payment of fine
7	he will be deported immediately without further proceedings.
8	SEC. 3. Implementing Rules and Regulations Within three (3)
9	months following the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of the Department of
10	Environment and Natural Resources shall promulgate the necessary rules and
11	regulations for its effective implementation.
12	SEC. 4. Repealing Clause All laws, presidential decrees or
13	issuances, executive orders, letters of instruction, administrative orders, rules
14	or regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are
15	hereby repealed.
16	SEC. 5. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
17	days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
