AN ACT TO GIVE JURIDICAL PERSONALITY TO THE PRESENT VETERANS MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER (VMMC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as "The Veterans
 Memorial Medical Center Charter of 2012".

3 SEC. 2. *Declaration of Policy.* – It is hereby declared the policy of the 4 State to help foster the socioeconomic security and general well-being of the 5 country's veterans and retired military personnel in recognition of their 6 patriotic services in times of war and peace for the cause of freedom and 7 democracy; for the attainment of national unity, independence and 8 socioeconomic advancement; and for the maintenance of peace and order in 9 keeping with the goals of the government and the aspirations of the people.

SEC. 3. Veterans Memorial Medical Center (VMMC) as a Corporate
 Entity. – There is hereby created a body corporate, for the benefit primarily of

1 the Filipino veterans, under the name of the Veterans Memorial Medical 2 Center, hereinafter referred to as the VMMC.

To provide greater flexibility in its operations, the VMMC shall be treated in a manner consistent with its institutional mission to serve the 4 5 veterans and shall be autonomous in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

6 SEC. 4. Purposes and Objectives of the Hospital. - The VMMC shall 7 have the following objectives:

(a) Construct, establish, operate and maintain veterans' hospital 8 9 primarily for the veterans' welfare;

10 (b) Stimulate and/or undertake scientific researches on the biological, demographic, social, economic, eugenic, physiological aspects of health 11 disorders and abnormalities and their control; and gather, compile, present and 12 publish the findings of such researches for public dissemination; 13

14 (c) Facilitate and encourage the dissemination and exchange of ideas 15 and information on the prevention, treatment and control of diseases; to arouse, 16 enhance and develop public interest and awareness on general health and 17 physical fitness;

18 (d) Encourage and/or undertake the training of physicians, nurses, 19 . medical technologists, health officers and social workers on the practical and 20 scientific conduct and implementation and delivery of health services, and 21 related activities;

22 (e) Assist universities, hospitals and research institutions in their 23 studies of health problems, to encourage advanced training on matters of, or affecting the physical and mental well-being of the people; 24

25 (f) Encourage the formation of other organizations on the national, provincial, city, municipal or barangay level and to coordinate their various 26 27 efforts and activities for the purpose of achieving a more effective and pragmatic approach on the common problems relative to the objectives herein
 enumerated; and

3 (g) Extend medical outreach programs to the general public to help 4 prevent, relieve or alleviate the innumerable afflictions and maladies of the 5 people especially the poor and the less fortunate in life, without regard to race, 6 creed, color or political belief.

SEC. 5. Social Responsibility. - The VMMC is primarily committed
to serve the Filipino veterans as defined in Republic Act No. 6948, as amended
by Republic Act No. 7696 and Republic Act No. 9396.

10 SEC. 6. *Powers.* – For the attainment of the above purposes and 11 objectives, the VMMC, as a body corporate, acting through its Board of 12 Trustees, shall have all powers pertaining to a juridical person, and is therefore 13 authorized to:

14 (a) Acquire and hold in any manner property of whatever nature or15 description;

16

(b) Enter into contracts;

(c) Solicit and receive donations, endowments and funds in the form of
contributions, whether in cash or in kind, from both the public and private
sectors;

20 (d) Open such accounts in banks and other financial institutions, and to
21 disburse such funds or invest the same as the Board may direct to accomplish
22 or advance the purpose or interest of the VMMC;

(e) Invite foreign health specialists and other similar experts in the
various medical fields to train the personnel or trainees or residents of the
VMMC;

(f) Send the VMMC personnel to research institutes, medical institutes
or universities for advance training or observation and to attend international
or regional conventions, conferences, congresses and seminars, as the Board

1 may deem necessary, to accomplish the purposes and objectives of the
2 VMMC;

3 (g) Enter into such agreements and arrangements with other medical or
4 other institutions, domestic or foreign, as may deemed desirable by the Board,
5 for the purpose of promoting its purposes and objectives;

6 (h) Adopt a set of bylaws, rules and regulations not inconsistent with 7 the law and the provision hereof to govern the administration and operation of 8 the affairs of the VMMC;

9 (i) Establish branches of the VMMC in other provinces or cities of the 10 Philippines as may be deemed necessary for greater service coverage to 11 veterans and their dependents that are living in almost all parts of the country; 12 and

(j) Perform all such other acts and things as are or may be necessary or
incidental for the accomplishment of the purposes and objectives of the
VMMC.

SEC. 7. Board of Trustees. - The VMMC shall be governed by a
Board of Trustees, composed of the following:

- (a) Secretary of the National Defense as Chairperson;
- 19 (b) Medical Director of the VMMC as Vice Chairperson;
- 20

) (c) Chairperson of the Senate Committee on Defense and Security;

- 21 (d) Chairperson of the House Committee on Veterans Affairs and22 Welfare;
- 23 (e) Secretary of Health;
- 24 (f) Administrator, Philippine Veterans Affairs Office;
- 25 (g) Chairman of the Philippine Veterans Bank;
- 26 (h) President of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines; and

27 (i) Three (3) appointive members who are veterans and who have28 distinguished themselves in their professions or areas of specialization and

have exerted conspicuous efforts towards the promotion of veterans' welfare
 and well-being. They shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines
 and shall serve for a term of three (3) years. In case of vacancy, such vacancy
 shall be filled in the same manner as provided for the predecessor, and such
 appointee shall hold office for the unexpired term.

6 SEC. 8. *Meeting and Quorum.* – The Board of Trustees shall convene 7 at least once a month. The Chairman of the Board may call a special meeting 8 whenever necessary: *Provided*, That the members are notified in writing at 9 least three (3) days prior to the said meeting. A majority of all the members of 10 the Board holding office at the time the meeting is called shall constitute a 11 quorum for Board meetings. In no case shall any and all members of the 12 Board appoint a representative to act on their behalf.

13 SEC. 9. *Medical Director.* – The Medical Director shall be appointed 14 by the President of the Philippines upon the recommendation of the Board and 15 shall serve for a term of six (6) years. The Medical Director shall act as the 16 Chief Executive Officer of the VMMC and shall perform the following 17 functions:

18 (a) Organize the VMMC into a streamlined medical institution with19 admirable facilities and competent staffs to ensure quality service;

(b) Appoint members of the professional and administrative staffs and
other employees or personnel of the VMMC through a screening process based
strictly on academic qualifications, experiences and other selection standards;
determine the terms and conditions of their employment, and remove them for
cause in accordance with law and due process;

(c) Determine a position qualifications and compensation plan and
adjust salaries and benefits for all personnel of the VMMC, subject to the
Compensation and Position Classification System of Governance Commission
for Government-Owned and -Controlled Corporations (GOCCs); and

1 (d) Carry out necessary managerial and administrative functions that 2 may be deemed necessary or as directed by the Board of Trustees in 3 furtherance of the objectives of the VMMC set in this Act.

4

SEC. 10. Secretary. - There shall be a Secretary of the VMMC as 5 appointed by the Board of Trustees, who shall be the Secretary of the Board and who shall keep such records of the hospital as may be designated by the 6 7 Board.

8 SEC. 11. Hospital Executive Committee. There shall be an **....** 9 Executive Committee consisting of the Medical Director as the presiding 10 officer and the Heads of the Administrative, Medical, Surgical, Rehabilitative, Dental, Psychiatric, Diagnostic and other critical medical departments. 11

12 13 The Committee shall exercise the following functions:

(a) Fix the requirement for admission to the hospital:

14

(b) Prescribe the rules and regulations as to the discharge of patients:

15 (c) Adopt internal rules of procedures consistent with the provision of 16 the Charter in order to promote administrative efficiency in the treatment, 17 rehabilitation and discharge of patients of the hospital; and

18 19

(d) Carry out administrative and managerial task to assist the Medical Director in the efficient operations and management of the hospital.

20 SEC. 12. Personnel and Medical Staff. - The VMMC shall have the 21 autonomy to employ such employees and medical personnel, or otherwise enter 22 such arrangements with medical specialists and other consultants as its Board 23 of Trustees shall determine. The personnel and medical staff of the present 24 VMMC shall automatically be transferred to and absorbed by the VMMC as 25 herein created. The incumbent Medical Director shall continue to serve as 26 such for a period of three (3) years or until his successor shall have been appointed by the President of the Philippines. 27

1 SEC. 13. Assistance from Government Offices. – The VMMC may 2 call upon any department, bureau, office, agency or instrumentality of the 3 government, including GOCCs, for such assistance as it may need in the 4 pursuit of its purposes and objectives.

5 All individuals, entities and institutions are hereby enjoined to render 6 full assistance and cooperation to VMMC in the accomplishment of its 7 objectives and activities.

SEC. 14. Property of the Medical Center. - All existing assets of the 8 9 VMMC including, but not limited to, the parcel of land belonging to the 10 private domain of the government situated in the District, Quezon City and more particularly described in the Bureau of Lands as Lot R.P.-3-B-4-A, 11 12 BSD-10352, all its buildings and other properties shall remain with the VMMC as a corporate entity, including those that may hereafter be given, donated, 13 14 acquired, transferred or conveyed to the Medical Center or its branches and instrumentalities by any foreign government, as well as those given by trust, 15 16 foundations, corporations or persons (alien or citizen). The absolute ownership of the Medical Center over these landholdings including those covered by 17 original and transfer certificates of title in the name of the VMMC is hereby 18 19 confirmed. Where the issuance of proper certificates of title is still pending for these landholdings the proper government office shall expedite issuance 20 21 thereof within six (6) months from the date of effectivity of this Act: Provided, That all registration requirements necessary for the issuance of the said titles 22 23 have been submitted and complied with.

24 25 SEC. 15. Land Grants and Other Real Properties. - The use of properties and proceeds of such properties shall be governed by the following:

(a) The State shall support the VMMC in the sum or lump sum amount,
through general appropriations and other financial benefits, and in kind,
through land grants and donations and use of other real properties. To carry

out the intent of these grants, income derived from the development of all land
 grants and real properties shall be used to further the ends of the hospital, as
 may be decided by the Board of Trustees in furtherance of the declared
 hospital objectives under this Act;

(b) Such parcels of land ceded by law, decree or presidential issuance to the hospital are hereby declared to be reserved for the purposes intended;

7 (c) The Board of Trustees shall plan, design and approve and/or cause 8 the implementation of contracts, mechanisms and financial instruments, such as 9 joint ventures, long-term leases, fully-owned subsidiaries and securitization to 10 give the hospital the flexibility to generate revenues and other resources from Provided. That such mechanism and 11 land grants and other properties: 12 arrangements shall sustain and protect the environment in accordance with law, 13 and be exclusive of the medical core zone of the hospital: *Provided, finally*, 14 That such mechanism and arrangements shall not conflict with the medical or 15 health services and academic mission of the hospital; and

(d) Any plan to generate revenues and other sources from land grants
and other real properties entrusted to the hospital shall be consistent with the
hospital mission and orientation as a vehicle to extend health services to
veterans and their dependents.

SEC. 16. Safeguards on Asset Disposition. - The preservation of the
value of the assets of the hospital shall be of primordial consideration. The
exclusive core zone of the VMMC as defined in Section 14 shall not be sold,
transferred, ceded, conveyed, assigned and encumbered.

SEC. 17. Annual Report. - The VMMC shall render to the President
of the Philippines an annual report of its activities and recommendations.

SEC. 18. Effect of the Dissolution. - If, for any reason, the VMMC is
dissolved, its property remaining at the time of such dissolution shall revert to
the Republic for disposition in accordance with law.

1 SEC. 19. Implementing Rules. – The implementing rules and 2 regulations shall be formulated within ninety (90) days from the approval of 3 this Act.

SEC. 20. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is
declared unconstitutional, all the other provisions not affected shall remain in
force and effect.

SEC. 21. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, executive orders,
rules and regulations or other issuances or parts thereof contrary to or
inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or
modified accordingly.

SEC. 22. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of
general circulation.
