AN ACT DECLARING THE PROVINCE OF MISAMIS ORIENTAL A TOURISM ZONE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Province of Misamis Oriental is hereby declared a tourism zone. As such, it shall be accorded priority development by the Department of Tourism (DOT) and shall be subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of tourist zones.

SEC. 2. The Province of Misamis Oriental is rich with small island ecosystems, waterfalls, beaches, rivers, sea and mountain resources; historical and natural landmarks; indigenous communities; and other areas full of potentials for the tourism industry.

SEC. 3. The DOT, in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare the necessary tourism development plan, providing for their development and maintenance, including improvement and restoration

of sites, where appropriate, in conformity with set forth standards, construction
hotels, resorts, restaurants, recreational facilities and other appropriate
facilities and infrastructure: *Provided*, That said development plan shall
ensure the preservation of the ecological balance and natural beauty of the
area/s concerned.

- SEC. 4. The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), in coordination with the DOT, shall set forth in place the necessary construction and/or improvement of roads and other infrastructure upon the promulgation of this Act and incorporate it in its infrastructure program.
- SEC. 5. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan and incorporate it in the Department's overall tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year. The DOT shall likewise promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 6. The Secretary of the DOT and the Secretary of the DPWH shall include in their respective Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act and/or charged against the internally generated funds of the DOT.
- SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
