AN ACT REQUIRING THE PHILIPPINE POSTAL CORPORATION TO
ISSUE POSTAGE STAMPS DEPICTING PHILIPPINE TOURIST
SPOTS, TO BE AFFIXED ON ALL INTERNATIONAL MAIL TO
ATTRACT FOREIGN TOURISTS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The Philippine Postal Corporation (PPC) is hereby
2 mandated to issue postage stamps depicting the different tourist spots in the
3 Philippines with appropriate labels, and in different denominations as may be
4 practical and convenient.
- 5 SEC. 2. The PPC shall ensure that tourism stamps are used in all
6 international mail.
- 7 SEC. 3. The PPC shall enlist the assistance of the Department of
8 Tourism (DOT) and the Tourism Promotions Board (TPB) in the
9 identification, illustration, and labeling of the tourist spots to be depicted in the
10 postage stamps.

1 SEC. 4. The DOT and the TPB shall assist the PPC in the preparation
2 of posters for placement in strategic places in the Philippines and in foreign
3 countries-in support of the international drive to arouse interest in the tourist
4 spots in the Philippines.

5 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
