AN ACT DECLARING MT. GUITING-GUITING NATURAL PARK, LOCATED IN THE ISLAND OF SIBUYAN, PROVINCE OF ROMBLON, A PROTECTED AREA AND ITS PERIPHERAL AREAS AS BUFFER ZONES AND PROVIDING FOR ITS MANAGEMENT

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. *Title.* This Act shall be known as the "Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park Act".
 - SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. Considering that Mt. Guiting-Guiting has one of the highest biodiversity in the country as it is home to a number of endemic species of flora and fauna, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to ensure its protection and preservation in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.
 - SEC. 3. Establishment of the Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park. Mt. Guiting-Guiting, located in the Island of Sibuyan, Province of Romblon, covering an approximate aggregate area of fifteen thousand four hundred seventy-five and 21/100 (15,475.21) hectares including its buffer zones, is

hereby declared a protected area under the category of natural park, more particularly described as follows:

SEC. 4. Definition of Terms. - As used in this Act:

- (a) Biodiversity refers to the variety and variability among living organisms and the ecological complexes in which these organisms occur;
- (b) Multiple use zone refers to an area where settlement, traditional and/or sustainable land use, including agriculture, agro-forestry, extraction activities and other income-generating or livelihood activities, may be allowed to be prescribed in the management plan. Land tenure may be granted to tenured residents, whether indigenous cultural community members or migrants;
- (c) Natural biotic area refers to an area set aside to allow the way of life of societies living in harmony with the environment to adapt to modern technology at their pace;
- (d) Restoration zone refers to an area of degraded habitat or where the long-term goal of management is to restore the natural habitat with its associated biodiversity excluding exotic species, and to rezone the area at a more strict protection level;
- (e) Special use zone refers to an area containing existing installations of national significance, such as telecommunication facilities, irrigation canals or electric power lines. Such installation may be retained subject to mutual agreement among the concerned parties: *Provided*, That such installation shall not violate any of the prohibitions contained in Section 20 of the NIPAS Act;
- (f) Strict protection zone refers to a portion of a protected area with high biodiversity value, which shall be closed to all human activity except for scientific studies and ceremonial or religious use by indigenous communities; and
- (g) Sustainable use zone refers to an area of high recreational tourism, educational or environmental awareness value where ecotourism, recreational conservation education or public awareness activities may be allowed.

1	SEC. 5. Establishment of the Protected Area Management Board
2	(PAMB) for the Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park The PAMB for the
3	Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park is hereby created and shall be composed of
4	the following:
5	(a) The Regional Executive Director (RED) of the Department of
6	Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) - Region IV-B as Chairperson;
7	(b) The Provincial Planning and Development Officer of the Provincial
8	Government of Rombion;
9	(c) The Municipal Planning and Development Officers of the
10	municipalities of Magdiwang, Cajidiocan and San Fernando;
11	(d) All barangay chairpersons whose barangays are within or inside the
12	protected area;
13	(e) A representative from the indigenous cultural community within
14	the protected area; and
15	(f) A representative each from the nongovernment organizations
16	(NGOs) or local community organizations in the municipalities of Magdiwang,
17	Cajidiocan and San Fernando.
18	The members of the PAMB shall be appointed by the DENR Secretary
19	in conformity with the provisions of the NIPAS Act. Each member of the
20	PAMB shall serve for a term of five (5) years and shall be considered to
21	represent one's sector and deemed to carry the vote of such sector in all
22	matters. In the case of members who are government officials, their
23	appointment shall be coterminous with their term of office.
24	The members of the PAMB shall be entitled to reimbursement of actual
25	and necessary traveling and subsistence expenses incurred when attending
26	meetings of the PAMB or any of its committees, subject to accounting,

budgeting and auditing rules and regulations, and subject further to the

availability of funds as reflected in the Work and Financial Plan (WFP).

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SEC. 6. Powers and Functions of the PAMB. - The PAMB shall exercise the following powers and functions: (a) Authorize the conduct of studies on various characteristics, features and conditions of the protected area; (b) Adopt a land use scheme and zoning plan in adjoining areas for the preservation and control of activities that may threaten the ecological balance of the protected area; (c) Cause the preparation of and exercise the power to review all plans and proposals for the management of the protected area; (d) Promulgate rules and regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act; 12 -(e) Deputize field officers and delegate any of their powers under this Act and other laws to expedite their implementation and enforcement; (f) Enter into contracts and agreements with private entities or public agencies as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act: (g) Approve administrative fees and fines for violations of the guidelines and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this Act; (h) Accept in the name of the Philippine government and on behalf of the protected area, funds, gifts or bequest of money for immediate disbursement or other property in the interest of the protected area, its activities, or its services; (i) Call on any agency or instrumentality of the government, as well as academic institutions, NGOs and the private sector as may be necessary to accomplish the objectives and activities in the protected area;

(i) Submit an annual report to the President of the Philippines and to

Congress on the status of the protected area;

(k) Approve the specification of the class, type, and style of building and other structures to be constructed in the protected area including the materials to be used; and

- (I) Perform such other functions as may be directed by the DENR Secretary, and such acts as may be necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes and objectives of this Act.
- SEC. 7. The Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) There is hereby appointed a Protected Area Superintendent from the ranks of the DENR Regional Office to be in charge of the management, protection and administration of the protected area. The PASu, as the chief operating officer of the protected area, shall be supported by the existing personnel of the DENR and shall be directly accountable to the PAMB.

The PASu shall bear full responsibility in the protection of land, water, wildlife and other natural physical and biological resources within the protected area. The PASu shall have the following duties and responsibilities in addition to those provided under the NIPAS Act and its implementing rules and regulations:

- (a) Establish, operate and maintain a database management system as decision support tool;
 - (b) Prepare the management plans as herein defined;
- (c) Provide a secretariat for the PAMB and supply the PAMB with all the necessary information to make appropriate decisions for the implementation of this Act;
- (d) Enforce the laws, rules and regulations relevant to the protected area, institute and file legal action independently or in collaboration with other government agencies or organizations and assist in the prosecution of offenses committed in violation of this Act:

(e) Monitor all activities within the protected area to ensure its conformity with the management plan;

- (f) Recommend the issuance of permits based on terms, conditions and criteria established by the PAMB;
- (g) Ensure the integration of the protected area's management policies, regulations, programs and projects with the national and local government programs; and
 - (h) Perform such other functions as the PAMB may delegate.
- SEC. 8. The Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park Management Plan. Within one (1) year from the effectivity of this Act, the PASu shall prepare a management plan in accordance with the General Management Planning Strategy (GMPS) and in coordination with the appropriate offices of the DENR, local government units (LGUs), local communities, NGOs, people's organizations (POs), and other people in the area who possess socioeconomic, anthropological and ecological expertise.
- SEC. 9. The Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park Protected Area Fund. There is hereby established a trust fund to be known as the Fund for purposes of financing projects of the protected area. All income generated from the operation of the system or management of wild flora and fauna in the protected area shall accrue to the Fund. These income shall be derived from permitted sale and export of flora and fauna and other resources from the protected area; proceeds from lease of multiple use area; contributions from industries and facilities directly benefiting from the protected area; and such other fees and income derived from the operation of the protected area.

The Fund may be augmented by grants, donations, endowment from various sources, domestic or foreign. Any donation or bequest made to the Fund shall be exempt from donor's tax and the same shall be considered as

allowable deduction from the gross income of the donor, in accordance with the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code of 1997, as amended.

The PAMB shall retain seventy-five percent (75%) of all revenues raised, to be deposited in any government bank within the locality; and that disbursements shall be made solely for the protection, maintenance, administration and management of the protected area and implementation of duly approved projects endorsed by the PAMB in accordance with existing accounting, budgeting and auditing rules and regulations: *Provided*, That the Fund shall not be used to cover personal services expenditures.

The remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the revenues shall be deposited as a special account in the National Treasury as share in the Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) created pursuant to Republic Act No. 7586.

The LGUs shall continue to impose and collect all other fees not enumerated herein which they have traditionally collected, such as business permits, property tax, and rentals of LGUs' facilities. The LGUs may charge add-ons to fees imposed by the PAMB: *Provided*, That add-ons shall be determined based on the contribution of the LGUs in the maintenance and protection of the protected area.

SEC. 10. Prohibited Acts and Penalties - The following acts are prohibited in the protected area:

- (a) Hunting, destroying, disturbing or mere possession of any plants or animals or products derived from the protected area without a permit from the PAMB;
- (b) Dumping of any waste products or introduction of activities detrimental to the protected area or to the plants and animals or inhabitants therein;

- (c) Using any motorized equipment within prohibited areas without a permit from the PAMB;
- (d) Mutilating, defacing or destroying objects of natural beauty, or objects of interests to cultural communities;
 - (e) Damaging and leaving roads and trails in a damaged condition;
 - (f) Squatting, mineral exploration, or otherwise occupying any land;
- 7 (g) Constructing or maintaining any kind of structure, fence or 8 enclosures and conducting any business enterprise without prior permit from 9 the PAMB;
 - (h) Altering, removing, or destroying or defacing boundary marks or signs;
 - (i) Extracting flora and fauna; and

(j) Mountain climbing, camping, spelunking/caving, researching, and conducting tour activities without permit from the PAMB.

Any person found guilty of any offense enumerated above shall be fined an amount of not less than ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) nor more than five hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00), exclusive of the value of the things damaged, and/or imprisonment of not less than one (1) year nor more than six (6) years, as determined by the court: *Provided*, That if the area requires rehabilitation or restoration as determined by the court, the offender shall also be required to restore or compensate for the restoration of the damage: *Provided*, *further*, That the court shall order the eviction of the offender from the land and the forfeiture in favor of the government of all mineral, timber or any species collected or removed including all equipment, devices and firearms used in connection therewith, and any construction or improvement made thereon by the offender. If the offender is an association or corporation, the president or manager shall be directly responsible for the act of his employees and laborers: *Provided*, *finally*. That, for such offenses, the DENR

1	may conduct separate administrative proceedings against the offender and
2	impose the corresponding fines and penalties in accordance with the law.
3	SEC. 11. Appropriations - The Secretary of the DENR shall
4	immediately include in the Department's program the implementation of this
5	Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
6	Appropriations Act.
7	SEC. 12. Separability Clause - If, for any reason, any part or section
8	of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, such other parts not affected
9	thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
10	SEC. 13. Repealing Clause - All laws, decrees, proclamations,
11	executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with this
12	Act are hereby modified or amended accordingly.
13	SEC. 14. Effectivity - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
14	its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation
15	readily available in and around the vicinity of the Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural
16	Park.
