AN ACT PROHIBITING MINING OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CARIGARA BAY AREA, LOCATED BETWEEN THE NORTHERN PORTION OF LEYTE PROVINCE AND BILIRAN PROVINCE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. All mining activities within the Carigara Bay, located between the northern portion of Leyte Province and Biliran Province, shall be prohibited.

As used in this Act, mining activities shall refer to the extraction of valuable minerals or other geological materials from the earth and shall include such mining activities as exploration, feasibility, development, utilization and processing as well as quarry operations involving cement raw materials, marble, granite, sand and gravel construction aggregates, whether large-scale or small-scale operation: *Provided*, That the quarrying of gravel and sand for projects directly undertaken by agencies of the national government or by the provincial government for basic services such as roads and bridges, school buildings, water and energy utilities and similar public works, is exempted from the coverage of this Act, subject, however, to the requirements of existing mining and environmental laws.

1	SEC. 2. Any person, entity, or a group of persons or entities who shall
2	violate the provisions of this Act shall be penalized with a fine of not less than
3	one million pesos (P1,000,000.00): Provided, That the owners, officers and
4	employees of firms or entities who violate any provision of this Act shall also
5	be held liable and shall be penalized with imprisonment of not less than one (1)
6	year nor more than three (3) years.
7	SEC. 3. Within three (3) months following the effectivity of this Act,
8	the Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall
9	promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its effective implementation.
10	SEC. 4. If any portion or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
11	unconstitutional, all other sections or provisions not affected thereby shall
12	remain in force and effect.
13	SEC. 5. All laws, orders, issuances, rules and regulations or parts
14	thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or
15	modified accordingly.
16	SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
17	in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
