AN ACT REVERTING FISH PONDS WHICH HAVE BEEN UNUTILIZED OR ABANDONED FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS TO FORESTLANDS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 43 OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 705, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "REVISED FORESTRY CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 43 of Presidential Decree No. 705, otherwise
known as the "Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines" is hereby amended to
read as follows:

4	"SECTION 43. Swamplands and mangrove forests.

6	"Mangrove and other swamps released to the Bureau of
7	Fisheries and Aquatic Resources for fishpond purposes which
8	are not utilized, or which have been abandoned for [five (5)]
9	THREE (3) years from the date of such release shall revert to the
10	category of forest land FOR IMMEDIATE REHABILITATION AND
11	REFORESTATION.

1 "THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES 3 SHALL DETERMINE, IN A SET OF JOINT GUIDELINES, 4 ABANDONED, UNDEVELOPED OR UNDERUTILIZED FISHPONDS 5 COVERED BY FISHPOND LEASE AGREEMENTS (FLAS)." SEC. 2. If any provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the 6 7 same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof. 8 SEC. 3. All laws, decrees, executive orders, issuances, rules and 9 regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly. 10 11 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication 12 in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
