AN ACT DECLARING MARCH 31 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE WHOLE PROVINCE OF SOUTHERN LEYTE IN COMMEMORATION OF THE FIRST MASS HELD IN LIMASAWA ISLAND, PROVINCE OF SOUTHERN LEYTE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "FIRST MASS DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. March 31 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in the whole Province of Southern Leyte in commemoration of the first mass held in Limasawa Island, Province of Southern Leyte to be known as the "First Mass Day".

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
