AN ACT MANDATING THAT ALL DECISIONS AND RESOLUTIONS RENDERED BY THE HOUSING AND LAND USE REGULATORY BOARD, WHETHER UNDER ITS ORIGINAL OR APPELLATE JURISDICTION, SHALL BE DIRECTLY APPEALABLE TO THE COURT OF APPEALS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. All decisions and resolutions rendered by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board in the exercise of the Board's quasi-judicial function, whether under its original or appellate jurisdiction, shall become final and executory after fifteen (15) calcular days from receipt thereof by the parties, unless a timely appeal is filed before the Court of Appeals.
- SEC. 2. The Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board shall promulgate the rules and regulations necessary to implement this Act.
- SEC. 3. Section 5(r) of Executive Order No. 648. series of 1981, Section 20(d) of Republic Act No. 9904 or the "Magna Carta for Homeowners and Homeowners' Associations", and all laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations that are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

- SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication.
