AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE KALANGUYA CENTER FOR  
THE 6<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT OF PANGASINAN, 1<sup>ST</sup> DISTRICT  
OF NUEVA ECIJA, AND THE PROVINCES OF  
IFUGAO, BENGUET, AND NUEVA VIZCAYA, AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. There shall be established under the National  
2 Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) a Kalanguya Center,  
3 hereinafter referred to as the Center, which shall have jurisdiction  
4 over the interior areas populated by the Kalanguya indigenous  
5 people in the 6<sup>th</sup> District of Pangasinan, 1<sup>st</sup> District of Nueva Ecija,  
6 and the provinces of Ifugao, Benguet, and Nueva Vizcaya.

7           SEC. 2. The Kalanguya Center shall be strategically located  
8 in the areas denominated in Section 1 hereof to ensure easy access  
9 of the Kalanguya indigenous people to its services. It shall maintain

1 service centers in Tinoc, Ifugao; Buguias, Benguet; Sta. Fe and  
2 Ambaguio, Nueva Vizcaya; San Nicolas, Pangasinan; and such other  
3 areas as may be determined by the NCIP Executive Director.

4 SEC. 3. The head of the Center should be a duly qualified  
5 member of the Kalanguya indigenous people (IP) and shall report  
6 directly to the NCIP Executive Director.

7 SEC. 4. The Chairperson of the NCIP shall include in the  
8 Commission's program the implementation of this Act, the funding  
9 of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations  
10 Act.

11 SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days after the effectivity of this Act,  
12 the NCIP Executive Director shall promulgate the necessary rules  
13 and regulations to govern the effective implementation of this Act.

14 SEC. 6. Any provision of law, order, issuance, rule or  
15 regulation inconsistent with this Act is hereby repealed, revoked, or  
16 modified accordingly.

17 SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
18 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general  
19 circulation.
