AN ACT DECLARING JANUARY 18 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY FOR ALL KASAMBAHAY IN THE ENTIRE COUNTRY TO BE KNOWN AS "ARAW NG KASAMBAHAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. January 18 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday for all *kasambahay* in the entire country to be known as "Araw ng Kasambahay". In the event that the special day falls on a weekend, the special nonworking holiday shall be observed on the Friday of that week.

SEC. 2. For purposes of this Act, the term "kasambahay" is defined under Section 4(d) of Republic Act No. 10361, otherwise known as the "Domestic Workers Act" or "Batas Kasambahay".

SEC. 3. The Secretary of Labor and Employment shall, in coordination with the Secretary of Education and the Director-General of the Philippine Information Agency, plan and implement activities for the continuing dissemination and information campaign to honor the *kasambahay*.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
