- AN ACT REQUIRING NEW PERSONNEL OF THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION TO BE CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTIONS 3 AND 8 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9263, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN OF FIRE PROTECTION "BUREAU AS THE BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY PROFESSIONALIZATION ACT OF 2004"
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Republic Act No. 9263, as amended, 2 is hereby amended by adding two (2) new paragraphs to read as 3 follows:
  - "SEC. 3. Organization and Key Positions of the BFP

1	"THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR SHALL DESIGNATE IN
2	EVERY FIRE STATION, AT LEAST ONE (1) UNIFORMED
3	PERSONNEL PER SHIFT, REGARDLESS OF RANK, TO ACT
4	AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN WHO WILL
5	SUPERVISE FIRE OFFICERS IN RESPONDING TO MEDICAL
6	EMERGENCIES.
7	"An Emergency Medical Technician refers
8	TO A TRAINED AND CERTIFIED PRE-HOSPITAL

16	SEC. 2. Section 8 of the same Act, as amended, is hereb
17	amended to read as follows:
18	"Sec. 8. Professionalization and Qualifications

22	the BFP and the BJMP in coordination with the CSC

THEIR APPOINTMENT, THE "UPON ABSORBED FIRE OFFICER 1 (FO1) OF THE BFP MUST UNDERGO AND COMPLETE THE FBRC, WHICH SHALL KNOWLEDGE FUNDAMENTAL PROVIDE THE SKILLS NECESSARY TO MEET THE MINIMUM STANDARDS PERSONNEL COMPETENCE, INCLUDING OF FIRE ADVANCED FIRST AID AND EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONSE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN COURSES. THE COMPONENTS AND COURSE DESCRIPTION OF THE FBRC SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INTERNAL RULES AND REGULATIONS ON MANDATORY SCHOOLING, SEMINAR, AND TRAINING, LOCAL WORKSHOP WHICH ARE ISSUED BY THE BFP. GRADUATES OF THE FBRC SHALL BE ISSUED THE APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATIONS AS MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDER AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN ACCORDINGLY.

"Uniformed personnel who are already in the service as of December 31, 2017 shall be given five (5) years to obtain the minimum certification requirement as Medical First Responder: *Provided*, That uniformed BFP personnel who have rendered more than fifteen (15) years of service as of December 31, 2017 shall no longer be required to comply with

12	affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
13	SEC. 4. All laws, executive orders, presidential decrees,
14	implementing rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent
15	with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified
16	accordingly.
17	SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
18	publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
19	circulation.
