- AN ACT DECLARING MT. TAPULAO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALAUIG, PROVINCE OF ZAMBALES AN ECOTOURISM ZONE AND FOREST RESERVE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared the 2 policy of the State to promote a safe and sustainable ecotourism 3 industry to attract local and foreign tourists.
- SEC. 2. Mt. Tapulao Ecotourism Zone and Forest Reserve. 
  The Mt. Tapulao in the Municipality of Palauig, Province of
- Zambales is hereby declared an ecotourism zone. The area of five
   thousand hectares (5,000 has.) of said mountain is hereby declared
- 8 as a forest reserve.

SEC. 3. Mt. Tapulao Ecotourism Governing Board. - An ecotourism governing board, to be known as the Mt. Tapulao

- Ecotourism Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as the Board. 1 is hereby created. It shall be composed of the following: 2 (a) The Governor of the Province of Zambales, as Chairperson; 3 (b) The Representative of the Second District of Zambales, as 4 5 Cochairperson; (c) The Secretaries of the Department of Tourism (DOT) and 6 the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), or 7 their duly authorized representatives; 8 (d) The Mayor of the Municipality of Palauig; 9 (e) A member of a nongovernment organization whose 10 advocacy is environmental preservation; 11 (f) A member of the academe: 12 (g) A representative from the business sector; and 13 (h) A representative from the private sector. 14 The Board shall promulgate the necessary rules and 15 regulations for the proper implementation of this Act by the 16 concerned local government units, and shall, as the need arises, 17 amend, modify or revise such rules and regulations to meet the 18 needs of changing times. 19 SEC. 4. Mt. Tapulao Ecotourism Master Plan. Within 20 ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act, the DENR shall 21 make an inventory of the existing flora and fauna in Mt. Tapulao 22
  - Within one hundred twenty (120) days after the approval of this Act, the DENR and the DOT shall develop a master plan, to be

8	executive orders, presidential decrees or other issuances contrary to					
9	or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby					
0	deemed repealed or modified accordingly.					
1	SEC. 7. Separability Clause If any provision or part of this					
2	Act is declared unconstitutional, the remaining provisions which are					
3	not affected shall remain in full force and effect.					
4	SEC. 8. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)					
5	days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any					
6	newspaper of general circulation.
