AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP) IN QUEZON CITY, NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PUP-QUEZON CITY CAMPUS, MANDATING THE PUP TO OFFER GRADUATE, UNDERGRADUATE AND SHORT-TERM VOCATIONAL COURSES THEREAT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP-Quezon City
 2 Campus Act".
- 3 SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the
- Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) in Quezon City,
- 5 National Capital Region (NCR), to be known as the PUP-Quezon
- 6 City Campus.
- 7 SEC. 3. The PUP shall admit students to its Quezon City
- 8 Campus who may avail of graduate, undergraduate and short-term
- 9 technical-vocational courses within the University's areas of
- 10 specialization, and according to its capabilities as the Board of

Regents (BOR)	may deen	necessary	to carry	out	the	University's
objectives, and to respond to the needs of the city and the NCR.						

The PUP is also mandated to undertake research and extension services in the Quezon City Campus, and to provide progressive leadership in these areas, including the offering of graduate degrees under the PUP Open University System.

SEC. 4. The PUP-Quezon City Campus shall be headed by a Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and who shall be appointed or designated by the BOR upon the recommendation of the search committee and the President, subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards set by the BOR.

SEC. 5. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
