AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TIMBANGAN NG BAYAN CENTER IN ALL MARKETS NATIONWIDE, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE CHAPTER II OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7394, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "CONSUMER ACT OF THE PHILIPPINES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. A new article to be denominated as Article 62-A 2 is hereby inserted after Article 62, Chapter II of Republic Act

No. 7394, otherwise known as the "Consumer Act of the 1 Philippines", to read as follows: 2 "ART. 62-A. ESTABLISHMENT OF TIMBANGAN NG 3 BAYAN CENTERS. - ALL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS, 4 THROUGH THEIR PROVINCIAL, CITY, OR MUNICIPAL 5 . TREASURERS, SHALL ESTABLISH A TIMBANGAN NG 6 BAYAN CENTER IN ALL MARKETS NATIONWIDE, PUBLIC 7 OR PRIVATE, INCLUDING FLEA MARKETS OR TIANGGES, 8 WHERE INSTRUMENTS FOR DETERMINING WEIGHTS 9 AND MEASURES SHALL BE OPEN FOR AND ACCESSIBLE 10 TO ANYONE WHO NEEDS TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY 11 OF THE QUANTITY AND MEASUREMENT OF THE 12 PRODUCTS THEY PURCHASE. 13 "THE SAFEKEEPING AND MAINTENANCE OF SAID 14 INSTRUMENTS SHALL BE UNDER THE CONTROL 15 AND SUPERVISION OF THE MARKET SUPERVISOR WHO 16 SHALL LIKEWISE BE IN CHARGE OF KEEPING A 17 RECORD OF EVERY PRODUCT FOUND TO BE WANTING 18 IN QUANTITY OR SUBSTANDARD IN DIMENSION, AS WELL 19 AS THE ESTABLISHMENT WHERE THE SAME WAS 20 BOUGHT, INCLUDING THE NAME OF THE PROPRIETOR 21 OR MANAGER THEREOF. A CERTIFICATION DULY ISSUED 22 BY THE MARKET SUPERVISOR OR AN AUTHORIZED 23 REPRESENTATIVE REFLECTING THE CONTENTS OF 24 SUCH RECORD SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF A 25 VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 64 OF THIS ACT. 26 "THE PROHIBITED ACTS RELATIVE TO WEIGHTS AND 27

"THE PROHIBITED ACTS RELATIVE TO WEIGHTS AND MEASURES PROVIDED UNDER ARTICLE 64 SHALL LIKEWISE APPLY TO *TIMBANGAN NG BAYAN* INSTRUMENTS."

SEC. 2. Article 64. Chapter II of Republic Act No. 7394. otherwise known as the "Consumer Act of the Philippines", is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "ART, 64. Fraudulent Practices Relative to Weights 4 5 and Measures. - The following acts relating to weights 6 and measures are prohibited: 7 "x x x "(h) for any person to fraudulently alter, TAMPER, 8 9 VANDALIZE OR DESTROY any scale. 10 TIMBANGAN NG BAYAN, weight or measure after it is 11 officially sealed:" "x x x." 12 SEC. 3. Article 65 of Republic Act No. 7394, otherwise 13 known as the "Consumer Act of the Philippines", is hereby amended 14 15 to read as follows: 16 "ART. 65. Penalties. - a) Any person who shall 17 violate the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (f) and 18 paragraph (1) of Article 64 OF THIS ACT or its implementing rules and regulations shall, upon 19 conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than 20 [Two hundred pesos (P200.00)] FIFTY THOUSAND 21 22 PESOS (P50,000.00) but not more than [One thousand 23 pesos (P1.000.00) THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300,000.00) or by imprisonment of not [more] LESS 24 25 than one (1) year BUT NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) YEARS

or both upon the discretion of the court.

1	"b) Any person who shall violate the provisions
2	of paragraph (g) of Article 64 OF THIS ACT [for the first
3	time] shall, UPON CONVICTION, be subject to a fine
4	of not less than [Five hundred pesos (P500.00)] FIFTY
5	THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) BUT NOT MORE THAN
6	THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300,000.00)
7	or by imprisonment of not less than one (1) [month]
8	YEAR but not more than five (5) years or both[,] upon
9	the discretion of the court.
0	"c) The owner,[-]possessor or user of instrument
1	of weights and measure enumerated in paragraphs (h)
2	to (k) of Article 64 OF THIS ACT shall, upon conviction,
3	be subject to a fine of not less than [Three hundred
4	pesos (P300.00)] FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00)
5	BUT NOT MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND
6	PESOS (P300,000.00) or BY imprisonment OF not
7	[exceeding] LESS THAN one (1) year BUT NOT MORE
8	THAN FIVE (5) YEARS[,] or both[,] upon the discretion
19	of the court.
20	"Provided, further, That two (2) successive
21	violations of this Act shall automatically result in the
22	cancellation of the business permit of the violator,
23	whether natural or juridical."
24	SEC. 4. Implementing Rules and Regulations The
25	Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and the Department

- of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), in consultation
  with the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines (ULAP),
  League of Provinces of the Philippines (LPP), League of Cities
  of the Philippines (LCP), League of Municipalities of the
  Philippines (LMP), and appropriate stakeholders shall, within
  ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act, promulgate
  the rules and regulations necessary to effectively implement
  - SEC. 5. Appropriations. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be charged against the internal revenue allotment and other funds of the local government unit concerned.
    - SEC. 6. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any article or provision of this Act, or any portion thereof, or the application of such article, provision, or portion thereof to any person, group, or circumstance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act shall not be affected by such declaration.
  - SEC. 7. Repealing Clause. All laws, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
- SEC. 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
