AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE
POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES
(PUP) IN THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA, PROVINCE OF
LAGUNA, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PUP-SANTA ROSA
CAMPUS, AUTHORIZING IT TO OFFER GRADUATE,
UNDERGRADUATE AND SHORT-TERM TECHNICAL-
VOCATIONAL COURSES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP-Santa Rosa
2 Campus Act".

3 SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the
4 Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP), hereinafter
5 referred to as the University, in the City of Santa Rosa, Province of
6 Laguna, to be known as the PUP-Santa Rosa Campus.

7 SEC. 3. The PUP-Santa Rosa Campus shall primarily provide
8 short-term technical-vocational courses, undergraduate and
9 graduate programs within the areas of competency and

1 specialization of the University, in pursuance of its mandate, and
2 according to its capabilities as the Board of Regents, hereinafter
3 referred to as the Board, may deem necessary to respond to the
4 needs of the province and of the Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal,
5 Quezon (CALABARZON) Region.

6 The PUP-Santa Rosa Campus is also mandated to undertake
7 research and extension services, and provide progressive leadership
8 in these areas, including the offering of graduate degrees under the
9 PUP Open University System.

10 SEC. 4. The PUP-Santa Rosa Campus shall be headed by a
11 Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and who
12 shall be appointed or designated by the Board upon the
13 recommendation of the search committee and the President of the
14 University. Such appointment or designation shall be subject to the
15 guidelines, qualifications and standards set by the Board.

16 SEC. 5. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of
17 this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

18 SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is
19 declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or
20 provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

21 SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules
22 and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of
23 this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

24 SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
25 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
26 circulation.
