- AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SINGLE CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR A CONSORTIUM OF SINGLE CLASSIFICATION SOCIETIES FOR CERTAIN VESSELS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 22 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9295, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "DOMESTIC SHIPPING DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 2004"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 22 of Republic Act No. 9295 is hereby
 amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 22. Classification of Vessels in the Domestic
Trade. – All vessels, whether newly built or previously
owned, which are acquired on or after the effectivity of
this Act shall be classed by a government-[recognized]
ACCREDITED OR AUTHORIZED classification society on
the date of acquisition prior to [its] THEIR operation in
the domestic trade.

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 "For this purpose, MARINA shall accredit

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 ONLY ONE (1) LOCAL CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR

1 CONSORTIUM OF CLASSIFICATION SOCIETIES THAT 2 SHALL CATER TO THE CLASSIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF SHIPS IN THE DOMESTIC TRADE WHICH ARE 3 4 MORE THAN THIRTY-FIVE (35) GROSS TONNAGE. 5 THIS IS WITHOUT PREJUDICE, HOWEVER, TO THE 6 MARINA'S AUTHORITY TO RECOGNIZE SURVEYS 7 AND CERTIFICATIONS OF ANY INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY WHICH IS A MEMBER 9 OF INTERNATIONAL. THE ASSOCIATION OF CLASSIFICATION SOCIETIES.

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11 "THE MARINA, GUIDED BY THE PRINCIPLES OF 12 MARITIME SAFETY AND PUBLIC SERVICE CONSISTENT WITH INTERNATIONAL BEST INDUSTRY PRACTICE, 13 14 SHALL SET THE POLICIES, RULES, AND GUIDELINES FOR 15 THE ACCREDITATION OF SUCH LOCAL CLASSIFICATION 16 SOCIETY OR CONSORTIUM, INCLUDING:

17 "(1) THE TRAINING, QUALIFICATIONS, AND CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF SURVEY 18 19 AND PLAN APPROVAL STAFF, AS WELL AS THEIR 20 SUPPORT STAFF: PROVIDED, THAT ANY APPLICANT 21 WHO COMPLIES WITH SUCH REQUIREMENTS SHALL 22 FORM PART OF THE CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY'S SURVEY 23 AND PLAN APPROVAL STAFF:

24 "(2) THE SCHEDULE OF SURVEY AND 25 CERTIFICATION FEES TO BE CHARGED BY 26 THE CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR A MEMBER 27 CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY; AND

28 "(3) THE COMPENSATION OF SURVEY AND PLAN 29 APPROVAL STAFF.

"IN THE EVENT THAT MARINA FINDS THE 1 ACCREDITED LOCAL CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR 2 3 CONSORTIUM NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH ITS POLICIES, RULES, AND GUIDELINES, IT MAY EXERCISE THE 4 TO CANCEL AND TRANSFER SUCH 5 DISCRETION ACCREDITATION OR AUTHORIZATION TO ANY QUALIFIED 6 LOCAL CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR CONSORTIUM, AS IT 7 PROVIDED, THAT THERE SHALL MAY DEEM FIT: 8 REMAIN ONLY ONE (1) ACCREDITED CLASSIFICATION 9 CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY OR CONSORTIUM OF 10 11 SOCIETIES AT ANY GIVEN TIME.

"THE MARINA SHALL INSTITUTIONALIZE A 12 CLASSIFICATION 13 PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT 14 SYSTEM THAT SHALL CATER TO REQUIREMENTS FOR 15 THE CLASSIFICATION WOODEN-HULLED SHIPS, AS 16 NONCONVENTIONAL WELL AS SHIPS WHICH ARE THIRTY-FIVE (35)17 GROSS TONNAGE AND BELOW THAT ARE USED IN 18 DOMESTIC TRADE." 19

20 SEC. 2. All laws, decrees, executive orders or rules and 21 regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended 22 or modified accordingly.

23 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
24 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
25 circulation.
