- AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABIAO, PROVINCE OF NUEVA ECIJA, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PUP-CABIAO CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP-Cabiao Campus Act".
- SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) in the Municipality of Cabiao, Province of Nueva Ecija, to be known as the PUP-Cabiao
- 6 Campus.
- 7 SEC. 3. The PUP shall admit students to its Cabiao Campus
- 8 who may avail of short-term technical-vocational courses,
- 9 undergraduate, graduate within its competency, areas of
- 10 specialization, as the Board of Regents may deem necessary to carry
- 11 out its objectives, and respond to the human resource development
- 12 needs of the Province of Nueva Ecija and the Central Luzon Region.

The PUP is also mandated to undertake research and
extension services in the Cabiao Campus, and to provide progressive
leadership in its areas of specialization, including the offering of
graduate degrees under the PUP Open University System.
SEC. 4. The PUP-Cabiao Campus shall be headed by a
Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and shall
be appointed or designated by the Board of Regents, hereinafter
referred to as the Board, upon the recommendation of the search
committee and the President, subject to the guidelines,
qualifications and standards set by the Board.

SEC. 5. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
