- AN ACT INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE SCHISTOSOMIASIS HOSPITAL IN PALO. LEYTE FROM TWENTY-FIVE (25) BEDS TO ONE HUNDRED (100) BEDS, UPGRADING ITS SERVICE FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE. AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF ITS MEDICAL PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The authorized bed capacity of the 2 Schistosomiasis Hospital in Palo, Leyte is hereby upgraded from 3 twenty-five (25) beds to one hundred (100) beds. The Secretary of 4 Health shall implement the increase in bed capacity of the Schistosomiasis Hospital for a period of not more than five (5)
 years from the approval of this Act.

3 SEC. 2. The existing service facilities and professional 4 health care services of the Schistosomiasis Hospital are hereby 5 upgraded commensurate to the increase in its authorized bed 6 capacity as provided for in Section 1 hereof.

7 SEC. 3. The existing workforce shall also be increased 8 correspondingly. The Secretary of Health shall, in coordination 9 with the Secretary of Budget and Management and the 10 Commissioner of the Civil Service Commission, and after 11 consultation with the Chief of the Schistosomiasis Hospital, 12 determine the additional plantilla positions to be created and filled 13 up.

14 SEC. 4. The Schistosomiasis Hospital may also provide15 general health care services to the public.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in
the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the
funding of which shall be included in the annual General
Appropriations Act.

20 SEC. 6 This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after 21 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper 22 of general circulation.
