- AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OCCIDENTAL MINDORO SPORTS ACADEMY AND TRAINING CENTER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN JOSE, PROVINCE OF OCCIDENTAL MINDORO AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established in the Municipality 2 of San Jose, Province of Occidental Mindoro, a sports academy 3 and training center to be known as the "Occidental Mindoro 4 Sports Academy and Training Center". It shall be located in the 5 Municipality of San Jose, and constituted as the primary sports

development and training center for the whole Province of 1 Occidental Mindoro and the neighboring towns. 2

SEC. 2. The Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro. 3 in coordination with the Municipal Government of San Jose, 4 and the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), shall take the 5 necessary steps to integrate existing sports facilities, equipment 6 7 and personnel in the province, into the newly created sports training center. 8

The Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro, in 9 coordination with the Municipal Government of San Jose, and the 10 11 PSC, shall create the necessary training programs, appropriate tournaments and competitions, as well as the system by which the 12 13 facilities shall be maintained and managed in order to accomplish the objectives and purposes of this Act. 14

SEC. 3. The construction, establishment and operation of 15 the "Occidental Mindoro Sports Academy and Training Center" 16 shall be funded by the Provincial Government of Occidental 17 Mindoro, the Municipal Government of San Jose, and with such 18 funds as may be granted by the PSC and by the Office of the 19 20 President. In addition, grants and endowments intended for sports development may be obtained from local or foreign sources. 21

SEC 4. The Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro. 22 in coordination with the Municipal Government of San Jose, 23 the PSC, and other concerned stakeholders, shall promulgate 24 the necessary rules and regulations for the implementation of 25 26 this Act within ninety (90) days after its enactment into law.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
circulation.
