AN ACT SEPARATING THE PANTUKAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL –  
TAGUGPO HIGH SCHOOL ANNEX IN BARANGAY TAGUGPO,  
MUNICIPALITY OF PANTUKAN, PROVINCE OF COMPOSTELA  
VALLEY FROM THE PANTUKAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL,  
CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH  
SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE TAGUGPO NATIONAL HIGH  
SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

- 1           SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*  
2   – The Pantukan National High School – Tagugpo High School Annex in  
3   Barangay Tagugpo, Municipality of Pantukan, Province of Compostela Valley  
4   is hereby separated from the Pantukan National High School and converted  
5   into an independent national high school to be known as the Tagugpo National  
6   High School.

1           SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,  
2 liabilities and records of the Pantukan National High School – Tagugpo High  
3 School Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Tagugpo National  
4 High School.

5           SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall  
6 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the  
7 Tagugpo National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged  
8 against the current year’s appropriations of the Pantukan National High School  
9 – Tagugpo High School Annex and funding support from the local government  
10 unit concerned. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation  
11 of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

12           SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such  
13 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

14           SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
15 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
