| | Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled: |
| 1 | SECTION 1. Section 86 of Republic Act No. 3844, otherwise known as |
| 2 | the "Code of Agrarian Reform in the Philippines", as amended by Republic |
| 3 | Act No. 7907, is hereby further amended to read as follows: |
| 4 | "SEC. 86. The Board of Directors; Membership, Per |
| 5 | Diem The affairs and business of the Bank shall be directed and |
| 6 | its property managed and preserved by a Board of Directors |
| 7 | consisting of [nine (9)] TEN (10) members to be composed of the |
| } | Secretary of Finance, as [Chairman] CHAIRPERSON, the President |

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of the Bank as [Vice-Chairman] VICE CHAIRPERSON, the Secretary of Agrarian Reform, the Secretary of Labor, and the Secretary of Agriculture as ex officio members. The President of the Philippines shall appoint two (2) members of the Board who shall represent the agrarian reform beneficiaries and two (2) members who shall represent the private sector. The two (2) remaining members shall be elected from the shareholders coming from the public sector to the extent that they may be entitled to two (2) seats in proportion to the outstanding capital stock. THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES SHALL APPOINT THE TWO (2) MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE AGRARIAN REFORM PROVIDED, THAT ONE (1) OF THE SAID BENEFICIARIES: REPRESENTATIVES SHALL COME FROM **ORGANIZED** AGRARIAN REFORM BENEFICIARIES FARMERS COOPERATIVE, IF ANY: TWO (2) MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE PRIVATE SECTOR AND ONE (1) MEMBER REPRESENTING THE COOPERATIVE SECTOR: PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COOPERATIVE SECTOR SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES FROM THE NOMINEES OF THE NATIONAL COOFERATIVE FEDERATIONS AND/OR UNIONS DULY
