SEC. 2. The Department of Environment and Natural Resources 4 5 (DENR) shall undertake the subdivision of the lands identified in Section 1 hereof into residential lots, taking into consideration actual land use and the 6 7 number of prospective beneficiaries. The residential lots shall be distributed for free to the residents of Barangay Combado, preferably the members of the 8 9 Combado Foreshore and Timberland Actual Occupants Association and bona 10 fide occupants of such lands not otherwise disqualified by law to own public lands and who do not own any parcel of land in the Philippines nor have been 11 beneficiaries of any land grant pursuant to the provisions of Commonwealth 12 Act No. 141, as amended, otherwise known as the Public Land Act, or any of 13 the agrarian reform laws: Provided, That no person shall be entitled to more 14 than one lot: Provided, further, That members of a family living under one 15 household shall be considered as one person. 16

17 SEC. 3. No residential lot acquired by virtue of this Act shall, without 18 the consent of the DENR, be sold, transferred, mortgaged or otherwise 19 disposed of within a period of five years from the date of the issuance of the 20 Certificate of Title. Any such sale or disposition made in violation hereof shall 21 be null and void *ab initio*.

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SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DENR shall issue the necessary rules and
regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
SEC. 5. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof
which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended
accordingly.
SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
