AN ACT SEPARATING THE DAVID MOISES MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL ANNEX IN BARANGAY TUMALALUD, MUNICIPALITY OF MAMBUSAO, PROVINCE OF CAPIZ FROM THE DAVID MOISES MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY BALIT, MUNICIPALITY OF MAMBUSAO, PROVINCE OF CAPIZ, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE MAMBUSAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

- 1           SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
- 2           – The David Moises Memorial High School Annex in Barangay Tumalalud,
- 3           Municipality of Mambusao, Province of Capiz is hereby separated from the
- 4           David Moises Memorial High School in Barangay Balit, Municipality of
- 5           Mambusao, Province of Capiz and converted into an independent national high
- 6           school to be known as the Mambusao National High School.

1           SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,  
2 liabilities and records of the David Moises Memorial High School Annex are  
3 hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Mambusao National High School.

4           SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall  
5 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the  
6 Mambusao National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged  
7 against the current year’s appropriations of the David Moises Memorial High  
8 School Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of  
9 the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

10          SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such  
11 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

12          SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
13 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
