AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LEGITIMATION OF CHILDREN BORN TO PARENTS BELOW MARRYING AGE, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE THE FAMILY CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES, AS AMENDED	
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:	
SECTION 1. Article 177 of Executive Order No. 209, otherwise known	
as the Family Code of the Philippines, as amended, is hereby further amended	
to read as follows:	
"ART. 177. Only children conceived and born outside of	
wedlock of parents who, at the time of the conception of the	
former were not disqualified by any impediment to marry each	

other may be legitimated[.]: PROVIDED, THAT THOSE

1	CONCEIVED AND BORN TO PARENTS UNDER THE AGE OF
2	MAJORITY MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR LEGITIMATION."
3	SEC. 2. Repealing Clause All laws, presidential decrees, executive
4	orders, proclamations and/or administrative regulations which are inconsistent
5	with the provisions of this Act are hereby amended, modified, superseded or
6	repealed accordingly.
7	SEC. 3. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
8	after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two newspapers of
9	national circulation.
