SECTION 1. Article 131 of the Labor Code is hereby amended to read
as follows:
"ART. 131. Exceptions. - The prohibitions prescribed by
the preceding Article shall not apply in any of the following
cases:
(a) In cases of actual or impending emergencies caused
by serious accident, fire, flood, typhoon, earthquake, epidemic or

1	` other disasters or calamity, to prevent loss of life or property, or
2	in cases of <i>force majeure</i> or imminent danger to public safety;
3	(b) In case of urgent work to be performed on
4	machineries, equipment or installation, to avoid serious loss
5	which the employer would otherwise suffer;
6	(c) Where the work is necessary to prevent serious loss
7	of perishable goods;
8	(d) Where the woman employee holds a responsible
9	position of managerial or technical nature, or where the woman
10	employee has been engaged to provide health and welfare
11	service;
12	(e) Where the nature of the work requires the manual
13	skill and dexterity of women workers and the same cannot be
14	performed with equal efficiency by male workers;
15	(f) Where the women employees are immediate
16	members of the family operating the establishment or
17	undertaking; [and]
18	(G) WHERE THE INCREASING DEMANDS FOR WORK
19	PROVIDE EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES TO WORK AT NIGHT; AND

1	[(g)] (H) Under other analogous cases exempted by the
2	Secretary of Labor AND EMPLOYMENT in appropriate
3	regulations."
4	SEC. 2. Repealing Clause All other acts, laws, executive orders,
5	presidential issuances, rules and regulations or any part thereof which are
6	inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.
7	SEC. 3. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
8	after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two newspapers of
9	general circulation.
